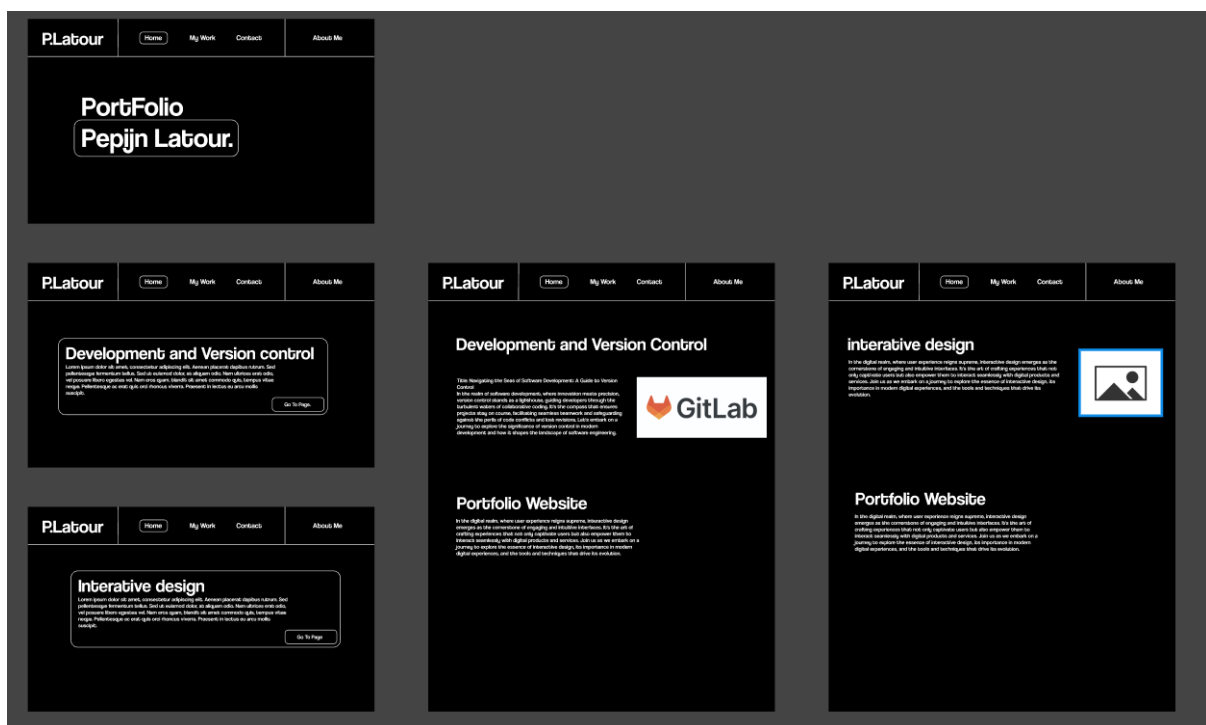


Portfolio feedback.

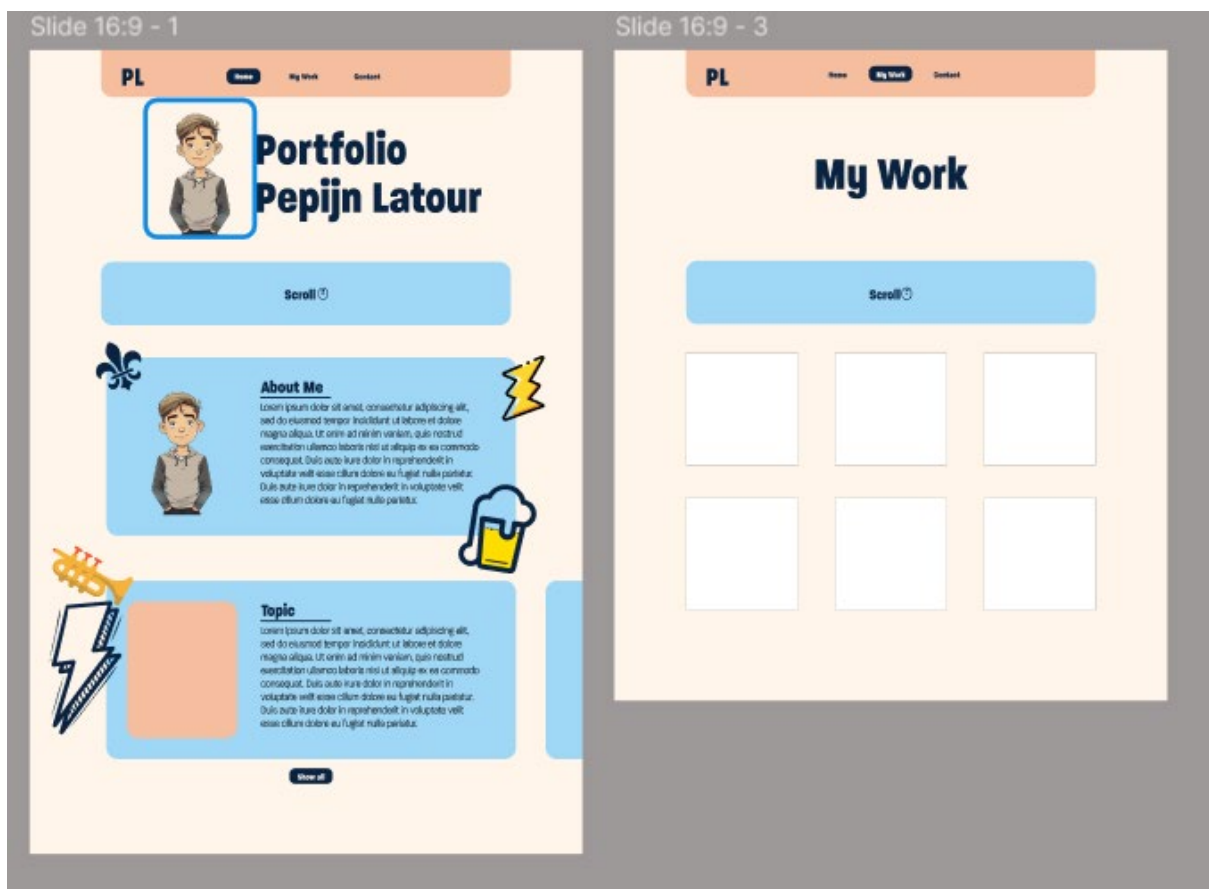
Translation:

Think carefully about what you want with your style. Also remember that your sources are well listed. Which websites did you use as an example? Grab a design and see what you like. You

already have a prototype of your website. This is not quite who you are. Step back and see how you make your portfolio show more of yourself.”

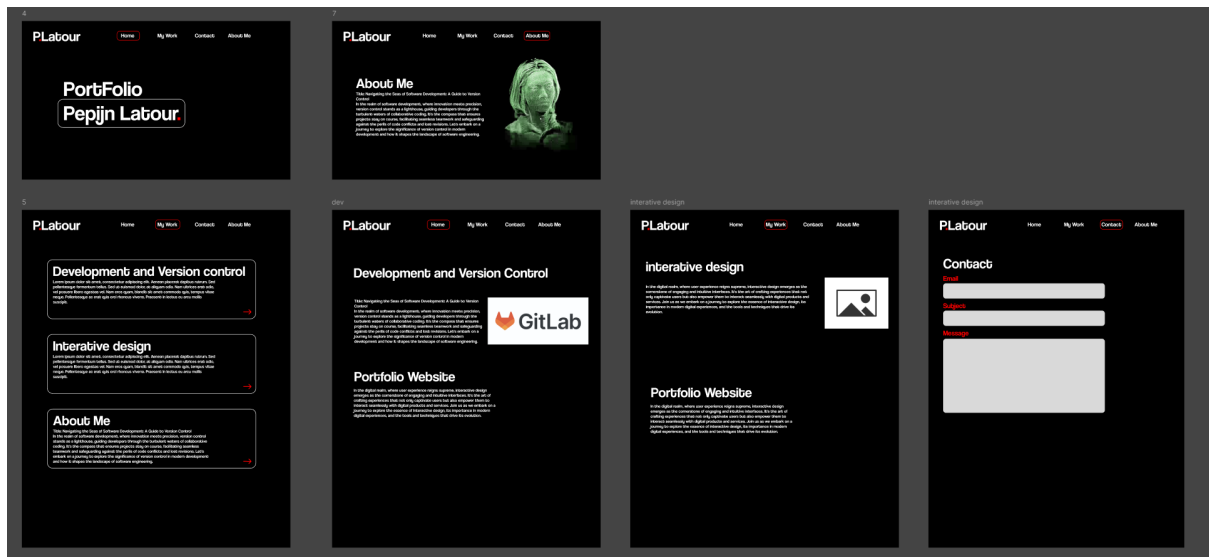


This was something different and it wasn't really what i expected to make so i asked for feedback and this is what i got from it:
